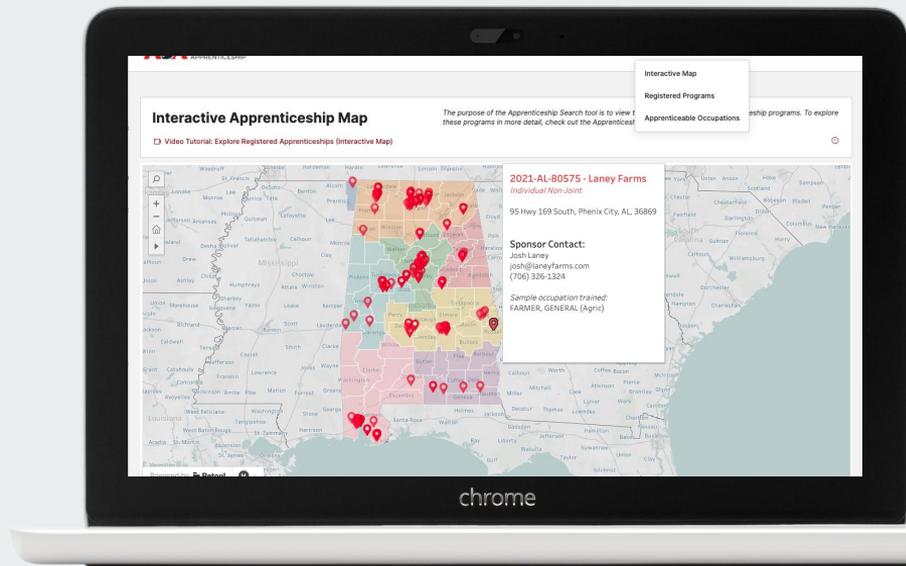

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About the Dashboard

The [Alabama Apprenticeship Dashboard](#) is the state's one-stop-shop for exploring registered apprenticeships. The tool was developed through a partnership between the Alabama Office of Apprenticeship (AOA) and the University of Alabama Education Policy Center to (1) link apprenticeship data to in-demand/employment information, and (2) provide useful, up-to-date information for anyone interested in apprenticeship, including students, parents, training providers, workforce agencies, and employers.

View interactive **apprenticeship map**

The [interactive apprenticeship map](#) displays the location of all registered programs with active apprenticeship occupations in the State. It includes information about the program sponsor contact, such as name, email and phone number, as well as a sample of the occupations being trained.



Search **registered apprenticeships**

The [registered apprenticeship programs search tool](#) allows users to explore apprenticeship programs registered by the Alabama Office of Apprenticeship.

Users can search registered program occupations by sponsor name, RAPIDS code or title, O*NET code or title, career cluster, program type (e.g. individual, group, etc.), workforce region, and state demand status. In addition to the search options, user can customize their table view in order to display the exact information that is of interest to them in one table.

Find **apprenticeable occupations**

With the [apprenticeable occupations search tool](#), users can search the U.S. Department of Labor's list of *nationally recognized* apprenticeship occupations.

Advanced filters can be used to modify search results. Specifically, users can search by RAPIDS code or title, O*NET code or title, career cluster, training type (i.e. time-based, competency-based, and hybrid), and/or State demand status.

Explore **in-demand occupations**

With the [in-demand occupations exploration tool](#), users can explore ACCCP's in-demand occupations lists.

Users can filter their search by occupation title or code, in-demand status, apprenticeable status, STEM status, career cluster, and education level.

Additionally, users can access both a *summary view* and *regional view*.

Note: the summary view organizes in-demand occupations by occupation title and provides users with O*NET SOC information, workkeys, rapids title and code, etc. Users can select a row to compare occupations across the seven workforce regions, information includes regional demand status, employment projections, growth rate, wages, and more.
